Item 1	<u>Applicant (owner name and address):</u> The applicant is the legal name of the entity (see Item 3 below) that owns the mark. The mark will be used to distinguish the goods or services of the owner from those provided by others. If the applicant is a partnership, each individual must be listed as the owner and each individual must sign the application before a notary public.																					
Item 2	<u>Contact person name and address:</u> Name and address of person we may contact with any questions we may have. Please furnish an email address, if available.																					
Item 3	<p><u>Applicant is a:</u> Select one of the entity types below that best identifies the type of entity of the applicant. 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Item 4	<u>Kind of mark:</u> Indicate whether you are requesting registration of the mark as a trademark or service mark. Use separate applications if requesting registration for a trademark and service mark. A trademark is any word, name, symbol, device or combination thereof, used by a manufacturer or merchant to identify its goods and distinguish them from others. (Example: brand names identifying goods such as Pepsi Cola for a soft drink). A service mark is any word, name, symbol, device or combination thereof, used by a manufacturer or merchant to identify its services and distinguish them from others. (Example: identifies services such as McDonald's for a restaurant service).																					
Item 5	<u>Identify trademark or service mark (or attach an exhibit):</u> Indicate the mark to be registered on this line. Type or write the words if the mark is comprised of words only. If the mark includes a design, symbol or image, attach an exhibit of the mark to the application. An exhibit is a separate sheet of paper depicting the appearance of the mark only without extraneous markings.																					
Item 6	<u>Registration fee and class number(s) of goods or services:</u> Indicate in which class you wish to register the mark. Classes are groupings or categories of goods and services (see 21 VAC 5-120-100). Trademark classes are 1 through 34; service mark classes are 35 through 45. The non-refundable registration fee is \$30 per class made payable to Treasurer of Virginia. (Example: The fee for registering a mark in two classes would be \$60).																					
Item 7	<u>Describe the product(s) or service(s) the mark represents (identifies):</u> Describe the product(s) (trademark) or service(s) provided (service mark) which the mark identifies. (Trademark example: manufacture and production of labeled brunswick stew for public consumption. Service mark example: Service which includes maintenance and repair of automobiles).																					
Items 8 and 9	<u>Date mark was first used:</u> Provide the dates the mark was first used anywhere and first used in Virginia. The mark must be in use, in commerce, in the Commonwealth of Virginia prior to submitting the application.																					
Item 10	<u>A specimen of the mark must accompany this application:</u> Provide a specimen of the mark which demonstrates the manner in which the mark is being used in commerce in the Commonwealth of Virginia. A trademark specimen may be an actual label and a photograph of the label affixed to the product, brochure, etc. A service mark specimen may be an original business card, letterhead, brochure, advertisement dated within the past year and the name and date of the publication in which it was published, a printed webpage on which the URL address and date are displayed.																					
Item 11	<u>Signature of applicant & notary public</u> – The application must be signed before a notary public.
